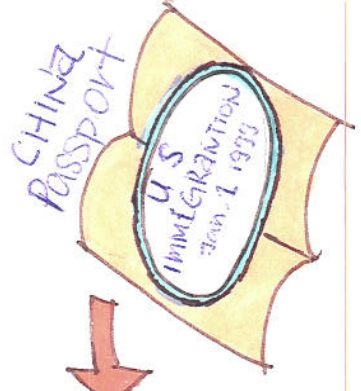
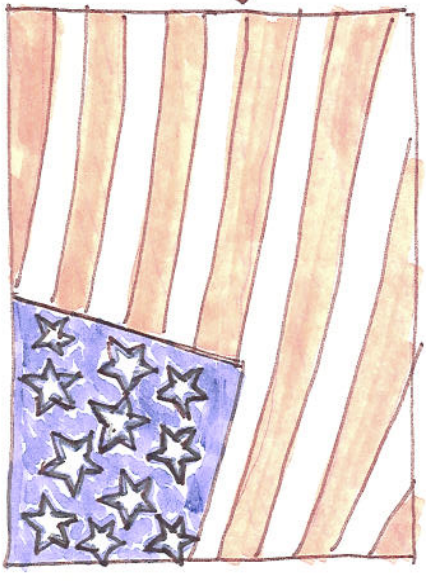
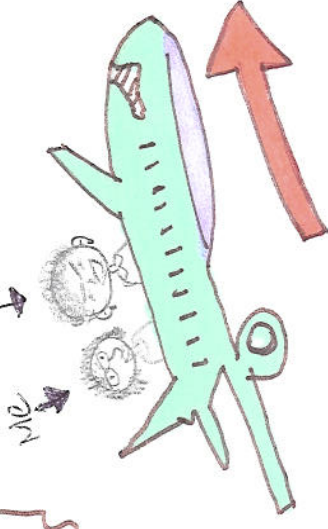


1. I was born Feb. 3 1983 in Canton, China.



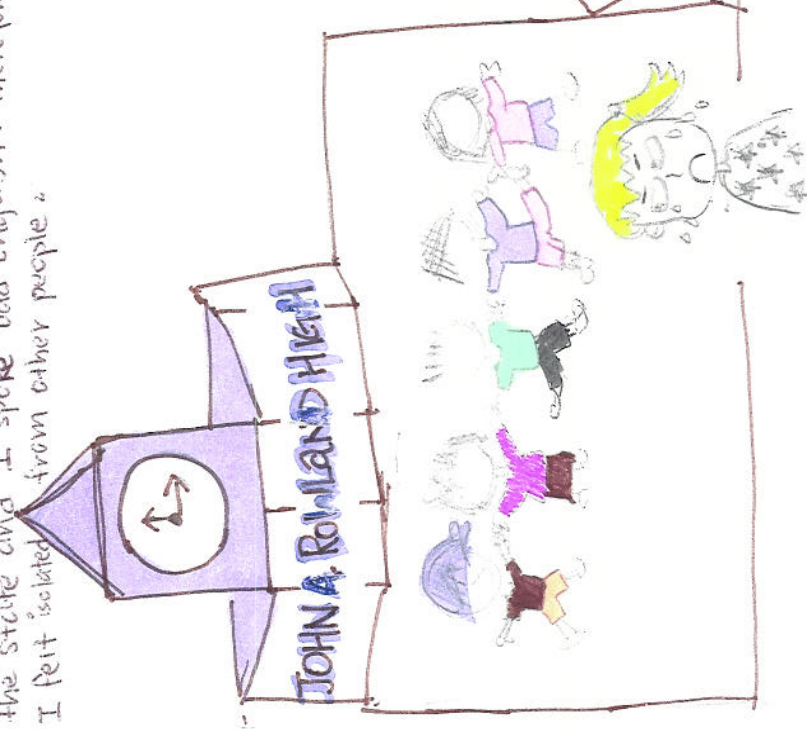
2. When I was 15, my parents made a decision to move to America because in America I can get better education than in China.

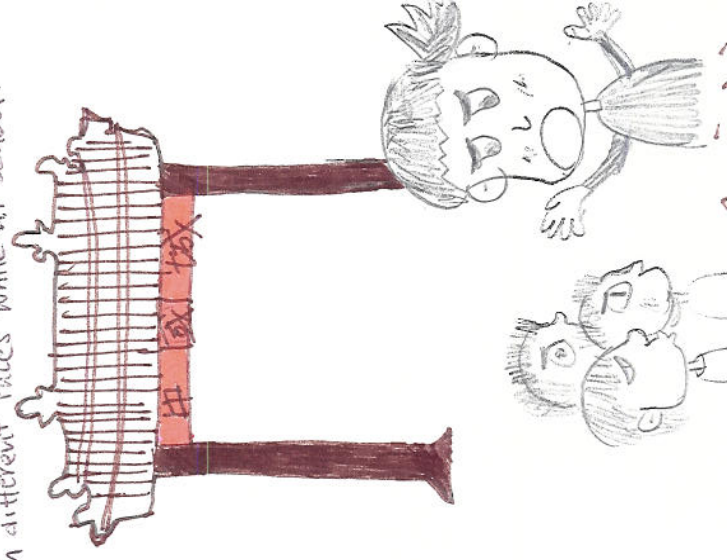
