 (Hosts Per 10,000 Inhabitants)

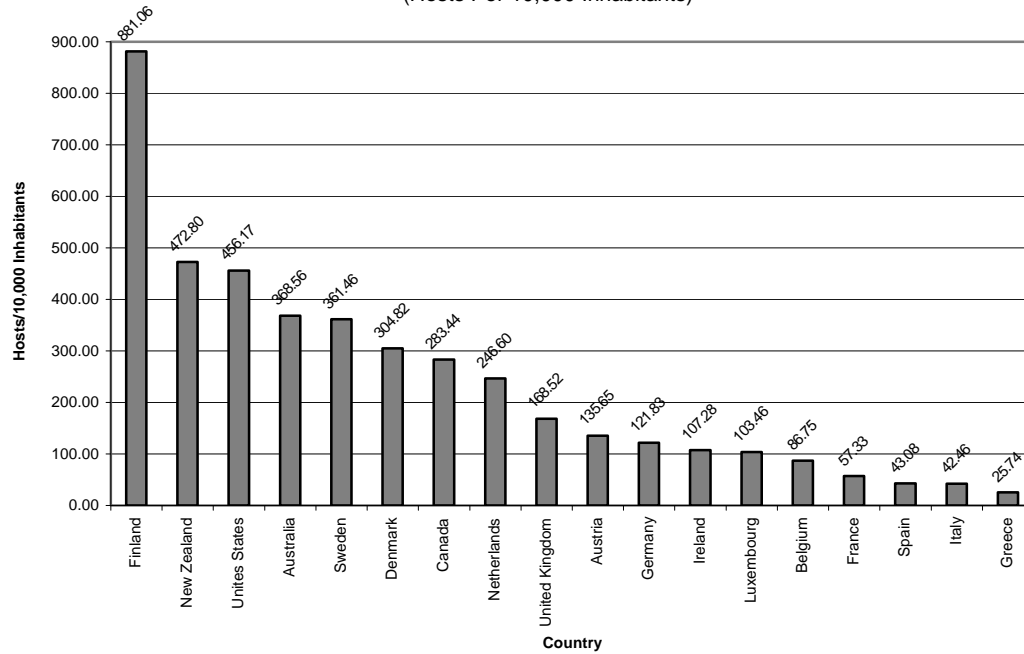
